


# <u>ACE BOOK CLUB</u>



We will have a community representative to host each site and guide patrons through appropriate physical distancing as they connect with their neighbours.

to perform in a socially-distanced manner. This may include poets and speakers, stilt-walkers, and mascots - more details to come soon! We are looking to include local partners and businesses to sponsor the cost of entertainers or provide corporate entertainment. We will have the entertainers move to a new food station every 20 minutes so that all our neighbours can enjoy their presence without having to go very far from their own backyard.


