



<u>Auntie Millie's Remedies</u> Getting rid of ants:

- 1. Ingredients Two (2) naval oranges, 1 tablespoon smooth peanut butter, one (1) pound of Swedish moose cheese, one (1) calcium silicate brick.
- 2. Carefully cut oranges into 2mm x 2mm squares
- 3. Spread peanut butter on oranges and mix with cheese.
- 4. Dabble mixture with <u>a blue soup ladle</u> over problem areas.
- 5. Hold brick approximately 2cm above ground near problem areas.
- 6. As ants approach, slowly but firmly lower brick.
 Hold for two seconds.
- 7. Raise brick back to 2cm above ground.
- 8. Repeat step 5 as necessary.


