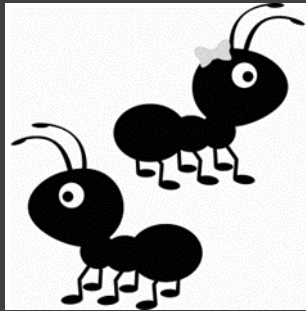

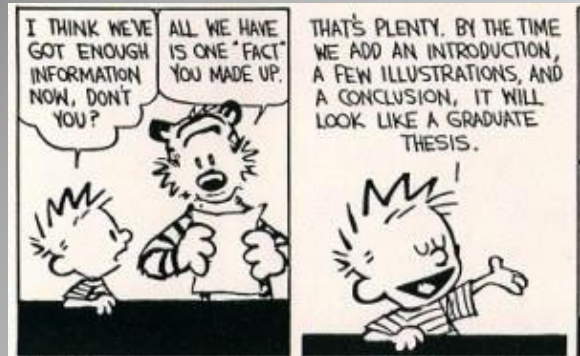

Auntie Millie's Remedies **Getting rid of ants:**

1. Ingredients - Two (2) naval oranges, 1 tablespoon smooth peanut butter, one (1) pound of Swedish moose cheese, one (1) calcium silicate brick.
2. Carefully cut oranges into 2mm x 2mm squares
3. Spread peanut butter on oranges and mix with cheese.
4. Dabble mixture with a blue soup ladle over problem areas.
5. Hold brick approximately 2cm above ground near problem areas.
6. As ants approach, slowly but firmly lower brick. Hold for two seconds.
7. Raise brick back to 2cm above ground.
8. Repeat step 5 as necessary.
